



Pride Toronto announces Pride 2012 dates

September 9, 2011 (Toronto, ON) – Pride Toronto announced today that the 32nd annual Toronto Pride celebration is scheduled from June 22 to July 1, 2012.

“This year, we decided to announce the dates for Pride 2012 well in advance to encourage anyone that wasn’t able to attend this year to incorporate Pride 2012 into their summer schedule,” said Pride Toronto Co-chair, Francisco Alvarez.

The 10-day Pride schedule includes the anniversary of the Stonewall riots during the first weekend and live entertainment, festivities and the Pride parade during the Canada Day long weekend.

The 2012 Trans march, Dyke march and Pride parade are scheduled for Canada Day long weekend to allow greater participation from local and visiting community members.
