Overview of Voting Method

Scenario One: If there are the same number of candidates as vacant positions (i.e., the Board's recommended slate), voting will proceed in one or two steps:

- 1. **Step 1:** Members will be asked to vote on a motion to approve the Board's recommended slate for election as a whole.
- 2. **Step 2:** If the motion detailed in Step 1 fails, the vote will proceed to yes/no/abstain voting for each candidate individually.
 - Winning candidates must receive 50% +1 yes votes.
 - Abstentions are not counted as part of the total vote percentage.

Scenario Two: If there are more candidates than available positions, members may vote up to the same number as available positions (e.g., if four vacant positions, members may vote up to four times).

- Successful candidates will be the top four candidates based on the votes received.
- Members may only vote for a candidate once.
- Abstentions are not counted as part of the total vote percentage.
